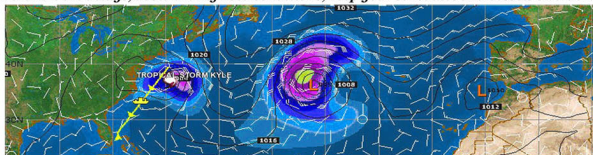

TROPICAL SYSTEMS

- WRI's continuous expert analysis of ALL tropical systems: disturbances, storms to hurricanes/typhoons.
- Daily WRI Tropical Summary for each ocean basin with continuous communication with land-based staff to minimize impact of tropical threat.
- Tropical systems analyzed with respect to vessels' schedule for potential impact.
- Tropical analysis, routing advice, wind/seas forecast direct to vessels affected.
